“BE PROACTIVE WITH YOUR GOALS!”

The month of September is the best month to set new goals in Toastmasters!

It is a new season in Toastmasters - a fresh start with new resources and new aspirations enabling us to envision great results. A new beginning is beneficial for the motivation and the enthusiasm it generates. So, now is a great time to set measurable goals for the next 10 months. Be realistic, be ambitious, and be courageous in setting your objectives.

When you set your goals in Toastmasters, relate them to your life goals. If you want to be an inspiring, persuasive speaker...focus on delivering a specific number of speeches this year, even to complete your Competent Communicator manual. If you want to become an influential leader...be active in the club and take on meeting roles. If you want to be more organized, become familiar with our new tool, Easy Speak, visit the website. It will support you in setting goals, tracking your goals and assisting you in signing up for the meeting roles that will help complete your Competent Leader manual.

Very important in setting goals is visualization, helping you to project your dream. If you can visualize yourself achieving your goals, you are more likely to achieve them.

Setting goals and seeing the result is an active process throughout the year.

“WHY EASY SPEAK?”

As time marches on there are new tools for managing Toastmasters meetings in an easier and more efficient way. Easy-Speak is one of such tools.

In the past this was a labourious task using a spreadsheet to track all the information. This method took hours of preparation by the VP Ed. In the end the roles were assigned and it was the responsibility of the assigned member to locate a replacement if they were unable to fulfill the role. This was often done the day before the meeting and sometimes not done at all. I saw this as a deterrent to the club and its members.

When I became VP Ed I asked myself “is there a better way?”. I started with a Google search. (What did we do before search engines?) This search resulted in the usual 800,000 hits, including:

- Agenda Builder
- Club Magic for Toastmasters
- **Easy-Speak**
- Scheduled Speaker
- TurboBase
- ClubScheduler

After reviewing the selection some were dropped due to cost, functionality, non-user friendly, limited and other criteria. With each evaluation pass Easy-Speak kept rising to the top like cream. I then again went to the web to find out what other clubs were using. Easy-Speak became the hands down winner. As a small select group of our members worked with Easy-Speak to determine its usefulness it constantly made our jaws drop and we drooled in anticipation...

The benefits of Easy-Speak include:

- ★ User friendly
- ★ Free
- ★ Supported with the developer and a large user base
- ★ Intuitive
- ★ Handles meeting scheduling, including roles and speeches
- ★ Tracks member’s progress for both completed speeches and leadership roles
- ★ Integration with the Toastmasters International organization

- ★ Ability to confirm attendance
- ★ User led role assignment versus roles assigned
 - * This allows members to own the role they sign up for
 - * This allows members to schedule their speeches coinciding with their schedule

It is the desire of the Fluor Communicators Executive to have a club that is healthy, productive and a good learning environment. It is the expectation of Fluor Management to produce staff who can speak eloquently to clients and peers; able to rise to the challenge of presenting to a full room and get the desired outcome.

In order for our club to produce such results we are implementing Easy-Speak - and we are doing it by jumping in with both feet! Comments from members so far have been positive. As often is the case with new methods it is necessary to ask questions. Myself and the other members of the Executive will be happy to answer them and you will be surprised how many members have started to use the program.

Easy Speak has a very efficient and user friendly way to keep track of your goals. I would encourage members to work with your mentors to set your goals. Once you start tracking your progress you can’t help but be motivated to complete your goals and move on with bigger and better ones!

A WORD FROM NEW MEMBER MATTHEW FOX




Outside of the professional environment, I can also see this being a great asset to aid me in continuing to coach sports teams and participate more actively in local councils, clubs and societies.


